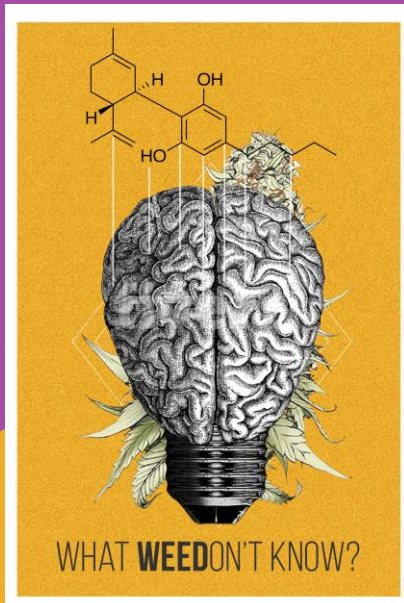
Do you want to know what soils and endocannabinoids have in common?
